Melbourne, Australia	Equitable & People-Centred	<p>[AND] Melbourne is a world-leading city in urban forestry, transport connectivity and liveability.</p> <p>[BUT] But, in recent years Melbourne is becoming a city of the “haves” and “have-nots”, with housing increasingly becoming unaffordable and accessible for those that can afford it.</p> <p>[THEREFORE] Therefore, I DARE MELBOURNE to take radical steps to reform local planning laws for the provision of sustainable housing developments, which are sensitive to their environmental footprint, strengthen social capital and community, and which adopt progressive rent/buying models that provide housing access to people from low-socioeconomic backgrounds.</p>	Tim, Comms Officer
